COCHRANE & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM & ASSUMPTION OF RISK

EVERY PARTICIPANT AT THE COCHRANE & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY MUST CAREFULLY READ THIS NOTICE BEFORE SIGNING. NO PARTICIPANT WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE PRIOR TO SIGNING THIS FORM.

"Inherent risks of equine activities" shall mean those dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to:

1. the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity;
2. the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
3. the equines response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects;
4. collisions with other equines, animals, people and objects;
5. the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability.

"Releasee and/or Releasees" shall mean the Cochrane and District Agricultural Society (CDAS), its user groups and affiliates, activity Organizing Committee(s), officials, volunteers, staff, and agents.

1. I release the Releasees from liability and waive as against the Releasees all recourses, loss or damages, including any consequential damage or loss, claims, causes of action of any kind whatsoever arising from my participation in the activity.
2. I voluntarily accept the legal risk, thereby expressly giving up any right of action and the physical risk arising from all liability whether such liability arises in contract, by reason of NEGLIGENCE or by reason of breach of duty raised by statute, or in any other manner whatsoever.
3. I further acknowledge and agree that:
 - a. The activity is dangerous, exposing participants to risks and hazards, some of which are inherent in the very nature of the reaction itself, others which result from NEGLIGENCE or FAULT on the part of the person involved in preparing and organizing or staging the activity;
 - b. As a result of the aforesaid risks and hazards, I as a participant may suffer injury, even death, as well as property loss;
 - c. Some of the aforesaid risks and hazards are foreseeable, but others are not;
 - d. I nevertheless freely and voluntarily assume all of the aforesaid risks and hazards and that accordingly, my use of the facilities while participating in the activity;
 - e. I understand the Releasees assume no responsibility or liability whatsoever for my safety while I am participating in an activity;
 - f. That I have carefully read the COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK, that I fully understand same and that I am freely and voluntarily executing same;
 - g. I understand that by signing this RELEASE, I be will forever precluded from suing or otherwise claiming against any of the Releasees for any loss or damage connected with any property loss, personal loss, personal injury, or death I may sustain while participating in the activity;
 - h. I understand the Releasees do not permit me to use the facilities now or in the future unless I sign the COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK and that this COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF RISK AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK applies to the activity whether occurring in the near or distant future and the terms of this agreement need not be brought to my attention each time I am a participant in the activity in order to be effective;
 - i. This COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK is binding on me, my heirs, my executors, administrators, personal representatives and assigns.
 - j. If I or any member of my family should incur an accident while on CDAS grounds I will complete an Incident Report (provided by CDAS) and submit to CDAS office.

COCHRANE & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Any breach of CDAS rules may result in revocation of ALL CDAS access and/or privileges.

1. **MEMBER AND/OR PASS HOLDER MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH CDAS.** Current year's fees and documents must be signed and submitted to office.
2. **CONDUCT** - member and/or Pass Holder will ensure that they conduct themselves in a manner which supports the multi-discipline aims & goals of CDAS while always being respectful of other riders and mindful of everyone's safety.
3. **CONFLICTS** - CDAS Conflict Resolution Policy must be followed in any and all conflict situations.
4. **USE OF PARK** - Any use of the park other than regular riding by Pass Holder must be pre-approved by the Operations Manager or designate.
5. **UNDER 18** – must be accompanied by parent or guardian at all times.
6. **CALENDARS** - member and/or Pass Holder will refer to and follow all postings on the event calendars.
7. **SIGN IN** - everyone must sign in daily on ARENA USER LOG located on office wall.
8. **CLEAN UP** after yourself & your horse – sweep or rake arena(s), alleyways, parking lot and/or stable area and pick up all litter and manure and place in proper receptacles. **A minimum fee of \$50 may be charged to the individual or group in the event clean-up is not completed adequately**
9. **LOCK CODES** are given out to Pass Holders upon payment of fees. These codes are confidential and are not to be shared with any other persons.
10. **GATES** - anyone passing through a gate or panel must return them to their original position.
11. **HEATING** – temperature controls in Indoor Arena are preset. DO NOT ADJUST. Please close all doors promptly upon entering to help reduce heating costs.
12. **LIGHTS** - only use lights if necessary. If lights are needed, try to limit to half of lights available. Turn off all lights when done.
13. **LOCKING UP** - last person to leave facility is responsible to lock all doors and gates and turn off all lights.
14. **GUESTS OF PASS HOLDERS** - Pass Holders are responsible for their guest's conduct and if guest is riding Pass Holder must ensure that all guest riders sign in on User Log sheets, sign a "Release, Waiver of Claim and Assumption of Risk" form and pay \$10.00 per day. Payment and form to be deposited in Drop Box on office wall.
15. **WATER** is provided for horses and watering facilities. DO NOT use for human consumption or for washing horses.
16. **SAFETY IS PRIORITY.** No lunging or equipment is permitted in the arena(s) if other riders present. All equipment must be removed if other riders arrive. Excuse yourself and your horse from the arena if at any time you feel that arena is too crowded or is unsafe for yourself or your horse's level of experience.
17. **NO LESSONS** are to be conducted in the arena when other riders are present.
18. **NO SMOKING** in any of CDAS buildings.
19. **NO FEEDING** of horses in arena(s) or alleyways.
20. **STABLING** is available at a predetermined fee. All stabling must be booked thru office.
21. **ACCIDENTS** must be reported by completing an Incident Report (provided by CDAS) and turned in to office.
22. **ALCOHOL/DRUGS** - No alcohol is permitted on the grounds unless proper approval and permits are obtained. Drugs and illegal activities are not permitted.
23. **DOGS** must be on a leash at all times.
24. **VETS OR FARRIERS** are not permitted to conduct business on Park grounds unless they are part of a commercial booking or in the event of emergency.
25. **RIDING TIMES** are from 5 AM to 12 Midnight when facility is not previously booked by a commercial user or a User Group. Utilize the Indoor Arena Schedule Boards, online calendar or information phone line to determine availability of facilities.
26. **TRAIL RIDING ON GROUNDS** - Pass Holders are welcome to trail ride on CDAS grounds with the exception of Pony Club arenas. No rider is allowed to jump Cross Country Course obstacles without a CDAS registered Instructor present.
27. **VOLUNTEERING** - Member and/or Pass Holder will be required to provide volunteer help for CDAS activities.
28. **QUESTIONS AND/OR CONCERNS** - Report all concerns and recommendations to the Operations Manager.
